



31st Street Bridge Replacement Over the C&O Canal

Notice of Temporary Daytime Single Lane Closure

Project Information

The 31st Street Bridge is located in Georgetown and spans the C&O Canal. The bridge is supported on stone masonry abutment walls and an 1867 cast iron multi-column pier. DDOT is replacing the structurally deficient, weight-limited bridge. In the process, the existing historic pier will be removed, restored, and reset.

Temporary Single Lane Closure on the Bridge Starting May 13, 2019

In order to perform preliminary work in the Canal, there will be a temporary single lane closure on the 31st Street Bridge during the Contractor's approved normal working hours: Monday-Friday 7:00AM – 5:00PM, and Saturday 9:00AM – 5:00PM.

There will be flaggers onsite to facilitate traffic movement, and pedestrian and bike traffic will be maintained at all times.

The single lane closure operation is expected to last approximately six weeks.

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
